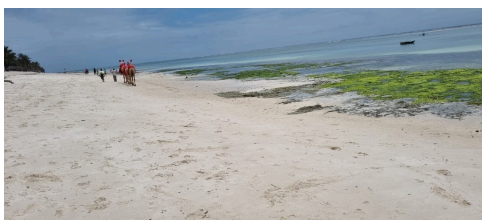
Pray for those in Kenya and east African areas suffering from years of drought, that God will send helpers to those dying of starvation, that compassion be given.

He keeps me in awe of His goodness as I've had this time to reflect on His purpose for my life... so that others will know Him. I came to see more of his handiwork in the twists and turns of my life. Some of you may have heard about the severe drought in Kenya by now. Pictures of the hundreds of animals lying dead due to the lack of water and vegetation are becoming more and more disturbing. The loss of African wildlife is devastating even to the protected animals which are endangered... zebra, rhinos and elephants, etc. The people who live off the land are having to herd their livestock to far places, finding no water or vegetation. At least 4 million Kenyans are on the verge of starvation. Mama's are unable to feed their children. According to CARE International 84% of children are dropping out of school to go find water for their families and what they find is often undrinkable. A family had 18 cows and now only 3 are left.

Last year I visited up north on a mission trip with Theovision. We met with members of the Turkana and Samburu communities doing training on use of the audio Bible. Now, I think of some whom we met are suffering from this drought. So, I ask that you join me in praying for these suffering. May God bring relief to areas in need of rain. Pray for those malnourished. And, for the animals in need of water. Pray for those seen standing on the roadside begging for water. Pray for the children having to leave school in search of water. May the lord God help the hungry, the starving and the dying to be comforted, to be fed and to be helped in this desperate time of drought. And, we pray for God's help to those working to help in this seemingly helpless situation. Help those who are giving their time and gifts to help those suffering from this drought to be protected and guided to walk with our suffering brothers and sisters in Kenya.
